FORMAT FOR WRITTEN & SPOKEN WORD ENTRIES

- Poem (written), Essay (written), or Spoken Word (audio or video accompanied by transcript)
- In the voice of anyone or anything: Use your imagination!

FORMAT FOR ART ENTRIES

- Notebook/sketchbook sized entry containing a written message (a caption or worked into entry itself)
- Drawn in colored pencil, pencil, pen or markers (make sure that it is clear)
